RESOLUTION NO. 16-01 LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT

RESOLUTION TO CLARIFY ARTICLE II, SECTION 2 (B) REGARDING LICENSED CONTRACTORS FOR PERFORMING A SOLID SEPARATION TANK INSPECTION USING TESTING EQUIPMENT APPROVED BY THE LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT, AND THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SUBMISSION OF SOLID SEPARTION TANK INSPECTION REPORT TO THE LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 2 (B) of the Little Colorado Sanitary District's Second Amended Rules and Regulations require users of the Little Colorado Sanitary District ("LCSD" or "District") to have their solids separation tank ("SST") inspected by a licensed contractor every five (5) years, and properties that contain a grease trap to have its SST inspected every one (1) year, to ensure the integrity of the LCSD's sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the LCSD's Board of Directors passed Resolution 14-0 in which users with an SST on properties without a grease trap are required to have their SST's inspected every eight (8) years; and

WHEREAS, the LCSD's Board of Directors recognize there may be confusion of (1) who is qualified to perform an inspection of a SST; (2) the equipment used for inspection of SST's; and (3) who bears the responsibility of submitting inspection reports to the District; and

WHEREAS, the LCSD's Board of Directors wish to clarify (1) who is qualified to perform a SST inspection; (2) the equipment to be used for inspections of SST's; and (3) the responsibility of property owners submitting SST inspection reports to the District.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT THAT EVERY USER OF THE LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT'S SEWER SYSTEM BEARS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF HAVING ITS SOLID SEPARTION TANK INSPECTED BY A CONTRACTOR WHO IS CERTIFIED \mathbf{BY} THE ASSOCIATION OF WASTEWATER TECHNICIANS ("NAWT") AND USES TESTING EQUIPMENT APPROVED BY THE DISTRICT'S ENGINEER, AND SUBMITTING ITS SOLID SEPARATION TANK INSPECTION REPORT TO THE LITTLE COLORADO SANITARY DISTRICT ON OR BEFORE THE STATED DEADLINE DATE. USERS SHOULD NOT RELY ON AN INSPECTION COMPANY TO SUBMIT THE INSPECTION REPORT. ANY USERS WHO SUBMIT AN INSPECTION REPORT AFTER THE DEADLINE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO LATE FEES PURSUANT TO THE FEE SCHEDULE THEN IN EFFECT.
